Saint John's Bible Print Exhibit – Closes Soon!
At the Scott County Historical Society
Closing May 22, 2010

(SHAKOPEE, MN 5/11/2010) —The Scott County Historical Society is host to a limited-run exhibit of *The Saint John's Bible* prints at the Stans Museum in Shakopee. Make plans to view the exhibit soon as it closes at 3pm on Saturday, May 22, 2010. The exhibit consists of twenty-five prints from *The Saint John's Bible*, commissioned by Saint John's Abbey and University in Collegeville, MN. As the first handwritten, illuminated Bible to be commissioned in over 500 years, this exhibit offers a stunning presentation of art and history. *The Saint John's Bible* incorporates medieval processes by the use of vellum, quills, natural handmade inks, hand ground pigments and gild. The exhibit includes hands-on activities for children and adults to gain a deeper understanding of the artistic process.
